The Collegium has an active roster of over 1,000 students, including over 170 transfer students, representing nearly every major on campus. Admission to the Campuswide Honors Collegium

There are two paths to admission to Campuswide Honors for prospective freshmen:

By Invitation

All high school applicants to UCI are automatically considered for admission to Campuswide Honors based on their UCI Admissions Application. Invitation letters are sent in early spring, and no additional application is required.

By Application

Many students join the program by application once enrolled at UC Irvine. UCI students are eligible to apply after completing one full quarter at UCI with a GPA of 3.5 or higher in 12 or more graded units. Students are encouraged to apply as soon as they are eligible, but no later than the end of week 2 of winter quarter of their sophomore year.
